Major projects

◦ ICOM CECA ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2012

From 20th to 25th of October, 2012 ICOM CECA Annual Meeting was held in Yerevan. The theme of the conference was "Museums and Written Communication. Tradition and Innovation". Around 150 participants from 37 countries arrived in Yerevan to take part on the conference. The Conference was live streamed on internet. The Conference was organized by ICOM Armenia in cooperation with the Ministry of Culture of RA, Open Society Foundation Armenia, Ararat Brandy Factory. The conference was honored by the official visit of the ICOM President Prof. Dr. Hans-Martin Hinz. First CECA Best Practice Award was granted in the Yerevan Municipality during the Conference opening ceremony.

◦ NATIONAL TRAINING ON MUSEUM MARKETING AND BRANDING

From 12th to 14th of April, 2011 the National Training on Museum Marketing and Branding was run by the experts invited from the USA; Lyndel King (Director and Chief Curator Frederick R. Weisman Art Museum) and Shelly Regan (President of Yamamoto Moss Mackenzie). 25 museum specialists from different regions of Armenia participated in this workshop.



◦ ICOM NATIONAL TRAINING ON HANDS-ON EDUCATION PROGRAMS

From 28th of September to 2nd of October the National Training on Hands-on Education Programs was conducted for the specialists of Armenian Museums. The experts of the workshops were Prof. Emma Nardi, (Experimental Pedagogy Department, Roma Tre University, and President of ICOM/CECA) & Prof. Marie-Clarte O'Neill (L'Ecole du Louvre). The training took place in the National Gallery of Armenia & the House Museum of Perch Proshyan in Asharak city. The training was organized by the ICOM Armenian & the Ministry of Culture of RA in cooperation with The Association of Museum Workers & Friends, DVV-international, A MUSE ALL.



◦ THE UNESCO/ICOM CAPACITY-BUILDING TRAINING FOR THE MUSEUM SPECIALISTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON MUSEUM MANAGEMENT

From 11th to 14 June, 2009 the National Capacity-building Training in Museum Management based on UNESCO/ICOM Museum Studies Training Package for the Museum Specialists of RA was conducted in Yerevan. The Training was arranged by four Armenian museums, including the National Gallery of Armenia, "Erebuni" Historical-Archaeological Museum-Reserve, Yerevan History Museum, Hovhannes Tumanyan Museum, in close cooperation with the Ministry of Culture of RA and the Armenian National Commission for UNESCO.
